

Technical Assistance on CSR Policy Advocacy Bohol Project

The USAID's Health Sector Development Program—LGU Strengthening Component or the Philippines Strengthening Local Governance for Health (HealthGov) aims to strengthen LGUs' commitment and support for public health services and their capacity to provide and manage quality health services, particularly those related to family planning, maternal and child health, tuberculosis, HIV-AIDS and other emerging infectious diseases.



A review of the health situation of the province reveals low performance in family planning, maternal and child health and tuberculosis (except for TB cure rate which is above national performance standard). In particular, some municipalities under the Inter Local Health Zones (ILHZ) of Tagbilaran and Jagna have low

Contraceptive Prevalence Rate of 28%. Thus within these ILHZs 10 municipalities were prioritized and piloted per recommendations from the Provincial Health Office of the province of Bohol.

The Participatory Research, Organization of Communities and Education towards Struggle for Self-reliance (PROCESS) – Bohol has been awarded by HealthGov to provide a technical assistance (TA) for the formulation of Commodity Self Reliance (CSR) Ordinance in the ten (10) identified pilot municipalities in the province of Bohol. These municipalities are Badayon, Catigbian, Cortes, Dauis, and Sikatuna of Tagbilaran ILHZ and the municipalities of Alicia, Candijay, Mabini and Guindulman of Jagna ILHZ and Loon for Loon ILHZ.
