The Sharing and Caring Others in Watershed (SCOW) Project is a 3-year holistic development initiative inside the Biliran Watershed, particularly in barangays Mahayahay and Lambonao in the town of Malitbog, Southern Leyte. Started in January 2007, it covers 40 families who received appropriate trainings, farm animals (native chickens, goats and horse), planting materials and other resources from the project. At the turn of one year, these original families will start to pass on some of the offsprings of animals and other 'gifts' to another batch of families in need within and outside their barangays. These inputs are aimed to strengthen family/group values to caring for others, improve family nutrition and increase income and savings.
